The Scholarship Program

This assistance is essential in helping the chosen students defray their educational cost in the areas of tuition, books, and uniform costs. Over the past decade, more than 60 participants, attending over 25 schools, have been afforded educational opportunities through Camp Tearnwork that might otherwise have not been possible.
